

2nd MED-MSP-CoP WORKSHOP

Monday, 21st October 2024

Hybrid and in presence at: Palais du Pharo (58 Bd Charles Livon, 13007 Marseille, France)

The MED-MSP-CoP organises 3 inter-connected technical workshops between September and December 2024. These workshops engage the MED-MSP-CoP members in:

- Discussing the main challenges related to the two subtopics selected by the MED-MSP-CoP: “Involvement of maritime sectors in marine conservation” and “MSP as a strategic framework for Sustainable Blue Economy”,
- Sharing knowledge about what is available from Mediterranean projects and other initiatives on MSP in terms of solutions,
- Identifying persisting gaps and related recommendations.

The workshops’ results will inform the elaboration of a short MED-MSP-CoP position paper on the two selected subtopics.

Focus and dates of the three workshops:

- **Workshop 1** aimed to share and discuss the results of the project and topic-based analysis performed by the MED-MSP-CoP in 2023 as well as the study on EMFAF MSP projects developed by the EU MSP Platform. A structured dynamic session was organized to discuss these results, identify other needs and solutions and prioritise challenges. **Date: 17th of September 2024, online.**
- **Workshop 2** will provide the opportunity to identify MSP-related challenges still to be addressed in the Mediterranean, discuss the reasons, analyse solutions provided till now and co-design additional needed solutions. **Date: 21st October 2024 in Marseille, hybrid.**
- **Workshop 3** will further progress in the co-design of solutions and recommendations to persisting challenges and discuss a draft version of the MED-MSP-CoP position paper. **Date: tbc in December 2024.**

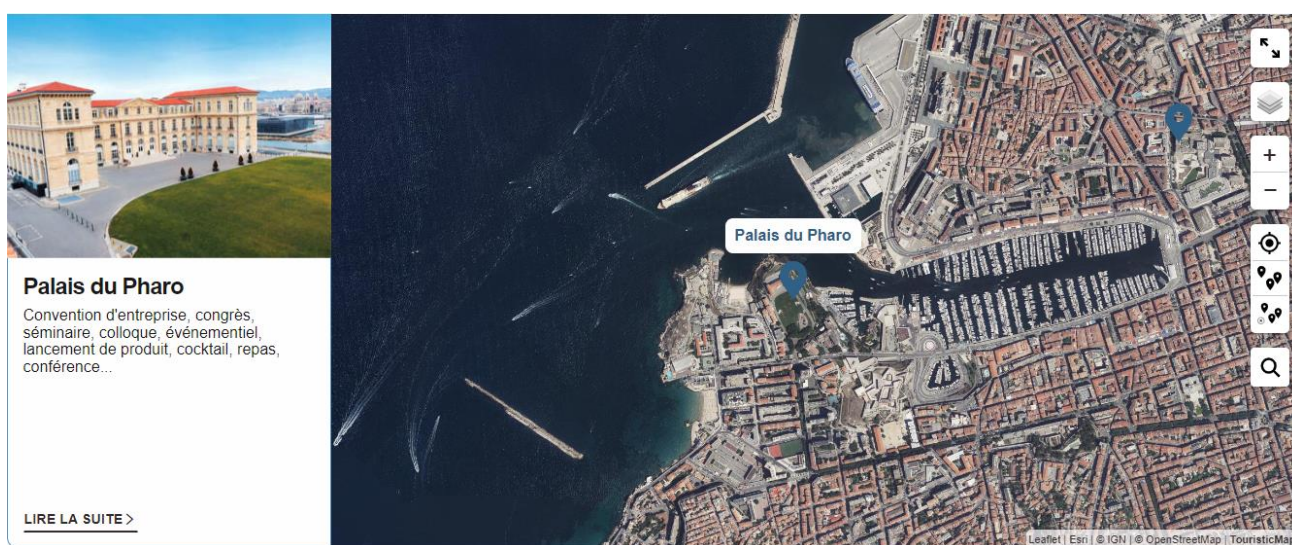

For participants in presence:

The meeting will be held in the **Palais du Pharo** (58 Bd Charles Livon, 13007 Marseille, France). The GPS position of the Palais du Pharo is 43.297386 - 5.375061.

**To get to the venue, there are different options:****From the Vieux Port:**

By public transport: You can take bus no. 83 (direction Rond Point du Prado) or buses no. 82 and no. 82S (direction Pharo/Catalans), 4th stop 'le Pharo' about 7 minutes.

On foot: (approx. 18 minutes), walk along the sea on the left (south) bank of the port and continue straight on until you reach the Palais du Pharo.

From St Charles station (and bus station):

By public transport: (Bus, metro and tram network - RTM www.rtm.fr): Under the station, get off at the metro station and take line M1 'La Rose - La Fourragère' (blue line) towards La Fourragère. Get off at the 'Vieux-Port / Hôtel de ville' stop. Take the 'Vieux-Port' exit (go straight on up the escalators, then turn right after the second escalators). Once on the Vieux-Port, you can use the RTM buses. The 'Métro Vieux Port' bus stop is 30 m in front of the metro exit): Then take the bus (see above: 'from Vieux Port').

On foot: (approx. 30 - 45 mins) Take the stairs from St Charles station down to the 'Canebière' (Boulevard Historique), then turn right onto the Canebière towards the Vieux Port. Once in the port, walk along the sea on the left (south) bank of the port and continue straight on until you reach the Palais du Pharo.
