Technical Sub-Group – Socioeconomic impact of MSP: OBJECTIVES

- To deliver practical approaches to integrate the economic and social dimensions in MSP.
- To advance knowledge and methodological approaches for gathering socio-economic data linked to MSP.
- To reinforce the provision of evidence-based decision-making by integrating the socioeconomic dimension.

Specific activities

- Review of peer-review articles, grey literature and current initiatives in Ireland, Italy and Spain
- Guest speakers: talks with economic experts from research projects (e.g. MOSES, MSPMED, CABFISHMAN, etc.)
- Survey to identify challenges on the implementation of socioeconomic aspects in MSP processes
- If applicable, pilot case study(es) to find out how is integrated the socioeconomic quantitative and qualitative data in a MSP process or in specific uses included in a MSP
- Provide examples of the data and data sources with socioeconomic indicators;
- Summary, results and updates in the report, and if possible, publication

- Survey of socioeconomic challenges - June 2022;
- Pilot case study(ies) – July 2022
- Summary, results and updates in the report, and if possible, publication – September 2022
